On November 17, 2010, Gilead hosted a public meeting for the Project at the South Marysburgh Central Public School. More than 150 stakeholders came to the meeting to speak with members of the study team about the publicly-released Draft Renewable Energy Approval (REA) documents and the Project in general.

In the weeks following the meeting, Gilead focussed on addressing stakeholder questions and making necessary changes to the REA reports to address stakeholder comments.

In December 2010, Gilead submitted its REA Application to the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) so that a REA could be issued for the Project. Following the MOE's assessment of completeness of the REA Application, Gilead was advised by the MOE that a second public meeting is required to fulfill the requirements of the REA Application process. As such, Gilead will be hosting a public meeting on April 12, 2011 to fulfill the requirements of the REA Application process. As part of the public consultation process leading up to the public meeting and in accordance with the regulation, Gilead will be releasing updated drafts of the documents to be submitted as part of the application (other than the consultation report) for public review and comment at least 60 days prior to the public meeting. The public review and comment period will officially commence on February 10, 2011 and end on April 12, 2011.

Please see the attached Notice opposite this page for additional information related to the release of the draft documents and the public meeting. Following the completion of the public meeting, Gilead will be updating the REA documents and will submit the REA Application to the MOE. If deemed complete by the MOE, the REA Application will then be posted to the Environmental Registry for a 30-day public review period (additional notification will be provided around the time of posting).

As per previously proposed, if approved, construction of the Project is scheduled to begin in August 2011, with testing in November 2011 and commercial operation in December 2011.

We look forward to receiving your comments and questions during the Draft REA review period and seeing you at the public meeting on April 12, 2011.

Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which the project is to be engaged in, is a Class 4 wind facility. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum nameplate capacity of 22.5 MW. The project location is described in the map below.

The Draft Project Description Report describes the project as a wind facility consisting of nine (9) GE xl 2.5 MW wind turbine generators, access roads, transformers included within each turbine, one on-site substation including transformer, and electrical collector lines.
