A MESSAGE FROM GILEAD

On February 9, 2009, Gilead Power Corporation (Gilead) released the Ostrander Point Wind Energy Park Draft Environmental Review Report (ERR) to the local community, agencies and other interested parties for a 30-day review and comment period. Although release of a Draft version of the ERR is not a requirement of the EA Act, Gilead's goal was to further their extensive and ongoing stakeholder engagement program and provide people interested in the Project with an additional opportunity to provide input.

In addition, Gilead has held two meetings in recent months with members of the local community in an effort to keep stakeholders informed of the Project and to answer questions and discuss comments about the Draft ERR. The first meeting was held on February 19, 2009 with the Alliance to Protect Prince Edward County, and the second was held on March 3, 2009 with landowners in proximity to the Ostrander Point Crown Land Block. Gilead thanks all those who took the time to review Project documentation and let us know what is important to them.

Gilead has always been interested in community feedback and has used it to develop and modify the Project design. Although this process takes some time, Gilead believes that the time we have invested has resulted in a more sustainable Project. To this end, Gilead is holding an additional meeting with the local community of South Marysburgh as advertised below.

Moving forward, the Study Team is completing additional on-site baseline studies, addressing comments submitted on the Draft ERR and incorporating these comments into the Final ERR where appropriate. We anticipate the Final ERR will be released for a 30-day agency and stakeholder review and comment period in the upcoming months. A Notice of Completion will be published in local newspapers, as well as mailed to all stakeholders on our mailing list when the Final ERR is released. As always, we encourage stakeholders to continue submitting questions and comments throughout the Environmental Screening Process, particularly as we are nearing the completion of the Final ERR.
