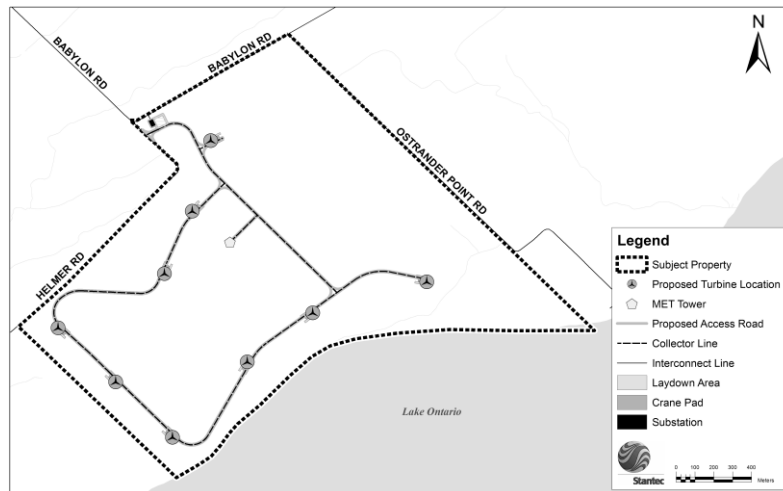
Gilead Power Corporation is planning to engage in this renewable energy project in respect of which the issuance of a Renewable Energy Approval is required. The proposal to engage in the project and the project itself are subject to the provisions of the Environmental Protection Act of Ontario (Act) Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09 (Regulation).

Project Description and Documents for Public Inspection:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which the project is to be engaged in, is considered to be a Class 4 wind facility. If approved, this facility would have a name plate capacity of 22.5 MW. The project location in the Township of South Marysburgh, Prince Edward County, is provided in the map below. The applicant has obtained or prepared, as the case may be, supporting documents in order to comply with the requirements of the Act and Regulation. Copies of the supporting documents have been made available for public inspection at: www.gileadpower.com, the County of Prince Edward (332 Main Street), and the Picton Branch Library (208 Main Street).

A proposal for a Renewable Energy Approval in respect of this renewable energy project was posted on the Environmental Registry (www.ebr.gov.on.ca; Registry Number: 011-5239) referred to in section 5 of the Environmental Bill of Rights, 1993 and that comments in respect of the proposal may be submitted to the Director. Originally, all comments received prior to January 29, 2012 would be considered as part of the decision-making process by the Ministry of the Environment if they are submitted in writing or electronically using the form provided in the Environmental Registry notice. Please note that the public comment period for Gilead Power's proposed Ostrander Point Wind Energy Park is being extended until February 19, 2012.
