Health & Safety

- Health and safety is of critical importance for our employees, contractors, and the community.
- Health and safety plans will be implemented during all stages of the Project.

Health and safety considerations addressed within the REA Reports include:

- Noise
- Low frequency sound
- Infrasound
- Electric and magnetic fields
- Shadow flicker
- Ice shed, and
- Structural hazards.

Low frequency sound and infrasound from current generation wind turbines are well below the pressure sound levels at which known health effects occur. There is no scientific evidence to date that vibration from low frequency wind turbine noise causes adverse health effects.
