Potential Natural Environmental Effects

Results of the Environmental Assessment:

- The length of new access roads have been minimized.
- Disturbance to local flora and wildlife habitat will be reduced to approximately 1.9% of the available habitat in the Study Area.
- Large contiguous areas of shrubland alvar will remain intact in the eastern portion of the Study Area.
- Disturbance effects to breeding grassland birds will be minimized.
- Tree and/or brush clearing will be completed prior to or after the breeding season for migratory birds (May 1 to July 23).
- Construction and operation will not reduce the amount of available habitat necessary to sustain current populations.
- No loss of species diversity is anticipated from the construction of the Project.
