Natural Environment On-site Surveys

- Our Environmental Assessments:
 - Occurred over all four seasons between August 2006 and June 2010.
 - Included site assessments of the vegetation communities and associated wetlands, wildlife monitoring surveys (e.g., mammals, amphibians, reptiles and birds), and a review of surface water features.
 - Included endangered species surveys for Whip-poor-will, Blanding's Turtle and Golden Eagle.
- The results identified the following significant features: provincially significant wetland and coastal wetland, significant woodland and significant wildlife habitat (seasonal concentration area for migrating landbirds; rare alvar vegetation communities, specialized habitat for woodland amphibian breeding and declining shrub/succession breeding bird species of conservation concern).
- No bat hibernacula or maternity roost features were observed within the Study Area.
